Our COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics have been a huge success. Across the entire campus, we have had only 8 residents decline the vaccination (7 still on campus). Our Independent Living resident participation was 95% and Assisted Living 98% (now 100%)!

Visitation Update:

Due to the overwhelming participation of residents receiving the COVID-19 vaccination, we feel comfortable being able to slowly start to reopen our doors. We remain under heavy regulation, and therefore, our reopening procedures and policies will differ in various areas of our campus. We will update with any changes.

Beginning March 1st, we will allow residents in Independent Living to have visitors. Assisted Living and Skilled Nursing are still required to be closed to visitors at this time.

Independent Living Visitation Rules:

1. All visitors must enter through the Main Lobby Entrance and utilize the COVID-19 visitor screening kiosk. You are not permitted to enter if you are not screened for COVID-19, no exceptions. When leaving, please use the same process by signing out at the screening kiosk. Please give yourself a couple extra minutes your first time as the system must collect additional information. It is much easier each subsequent visit!
2. All visitors must wear a mask the entire duration of their visit unless eating or drinking, no exceptions.
3. At this time, visits can only be conducted in the resident's home. Please immediately proceed to the resident's home within the VGV Campus.
4. Due to capacity restrictions in the dining rooms and our need for systematic reopening, we are unable to accommodate guests in our restaurants. Residents are permitted to place orders for guests for in-home delivery. Guest meals will be charged to the resident's incline account.

Dining Update:

The Magnolia Room reopening has been successful, and we hope to see more and more residents taking advantage of coming back to our restaurants. Beginning March 2nd, the Rose Room will be reopening for dinner, Tuesday – Friday by reservation only, with seatings at 4:00pm, 5:00pm, and 6:00pm. Residents are able to make a reservation 24 hours in advance by visiting the reservation table located just outside of the Rose Room or by calling the Dining Services cell phone at: 517-581-3323. We ask that you place your order ahead of time in order for our team to have this ready for you shortly after arrival.
